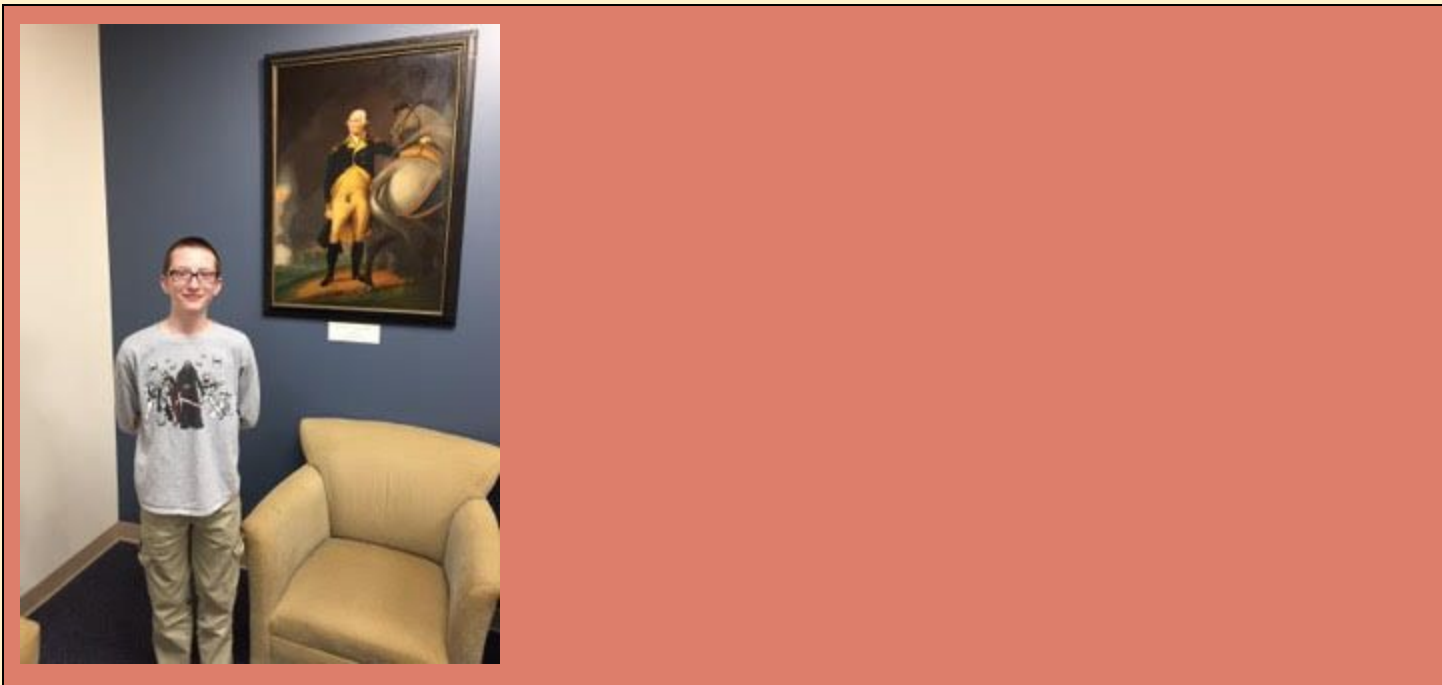
## School News
