

JIA STUDENT DUE PROCESS RIGHTS

See also JI, JIC, JICD

Students facing discipline will be afforded all due process rights given by law. The Dean or his/her written designee is authorized to suspend any student for ten days or less for violations of school rules or policies. Should the Dean desire to suspend a student for more than ten days, such student will be afforded a hearing before the school board. In addition to the provisions of this policy, the Board recognizes the application of all pertinent provisions of RSA

193:13 and associated Department of Education rules.

Student due process rights shall be printed in the Parent-Student Handbook and will be made available in another language or presented orally upon request.

The school board may, unless otherwise provided by statute or state board regulations, prescribe regulations for the attendance upon, and for the management, classification and discipline of, the schools; and such regulations, when recorded in the official records of the school board, shall be binding upon pupils and teachers.
